Dear Parent

Greetings of the Day!

As educational partners, we prioritize the well-being and safety of all our students, and with the onset of monsoon season, in order to prevent spread of contagious diseases within our school community, we kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following advisory:

- If your child is suffering from any Common contagious disease like Influenza (flu), common cold, strep throat, chickenpox, measles, mumps, conjunctivitis and other similar illnesses-
 - We urge you to keep your child at home until [s]he has fully recovered.
 - It is vital to consult a healthcare professional for appropriate treatment and guidance.
 - Please notify the school of your child's condition, providing relevant medical documentation when available, to facilitate necessary precautions and support.
- Why keeping children with contagious diseases at home is crucial:
 - Preventing the spread: Contagious diseases can easily transmit from person to person, especially within the close proximity of a school environment. By keeping affected children at home, we can minimize the risk of outbreaks and protect the health of our entire school community.
 - Safeguarding vulnerable individuals: Some students may have weakened immune systems or pre-existing health conditions that make them more susceptible to complications from contagious diseases. By preventing the spread, we create a safer environment for all students.
- Educational support during absences:
 - We understand the importance of education and will work closely with you to provide appropriate academic support for your child during absence. Our teachers will assist in sharing study materials and assignments to ensure minimal disruption to our student's learning.
 - Further Class Test / Cycle Test / Periodic Test are currently going on and it has been found that some parent are giving their wards fever suppressants and sending them to school which is highly detrimental to the physical, mental and social growth of the children.
 - In case your child is unwell, submit an application along with Medical Certificate at the school reception or email to get weightage in the Exam/ Test.
- Promoting preventive measures: Reinforce good hygiene practices at home- wash hands frequently, cover mouth while coughing and sneezing and avoid close contact with any person showing symptoms of contagious diseases.
