Greetings of the day!

Vide circular 'S36 School Safe Zone - Data Collection' dated 20 December, 2022, on the School Website, details of the prestigious pilot project, SENSITIVE Abode of Learning (SEAL) - School Safe Zone, begun as per the circular issued by DOE vide Addl.DE/Misc/2022/819-24 dated 30 May, 2022, in collaboration with an NGO HumanQind, a lead partner of TRIP Centre, IIT, Delhi were shared with you.

The initiative was launched with the primary objective of enhancing safety in the vicinity of the school, particularly in areas with significant child pedestrian traffic. It engaged all stakeholders - Students, Teachers, Alumni, Parents, and School Management in visualizing and designing a model - the School Safe Zone - to make movement of students to and from school safe. The cumulation of this collaboration was a model, which was put on paper by the team of architects from HumanQind and the final blueprint has been sent to the Government Authorities for further approval.

With an upcoming visit from the government officials, we can formally share that the project is progressing towards its final stages. This visit marks an important milestone, paving the way for the commencement of the redesigning process of the main road in front of our school.
