Important Notice Regarding Social Media Conduct

Dear Parents and Students

Following our previous circular “[C1 Academic Session 2025-26 – Together Towards Excellence](#)” dated [01 April, 2025](#), which is available on the School Website, we would like to draw your attention to page 14, “[Model Code of Conduct for Students](#),” and page 15, “[Guidelines for Parents in the School](#)” of the School Almanac.

We must reiterate the importance of parents monitoring their children’s social media usage, as concerns have been raised regarding misuse by students. In response, we are implementing strict measures to ensure the safety and well-being of all students.

The school does not have any social media group, rather all students and teachers are discouraged from forming groups or participating in any group involving school community. We request you to bring any such group to the notice of the Class teacher, Counsellor or undersigned immediately. It has been brought to our notice that students are using certain Applications through which they can post messages without revealing their identity. These anonymous messages sent through the specified links are non traceable thereby inciting students to post hate mail and troll others on public domain in the most irresponsible manner.

Parents are requested to keep a strict vigil on their ward’s Online interactions. Since it is not technically possible to be aware of offensive posts without being actively involved in it, a close watch is required to monitor the media interactions. Any objectionable interaction, if reported will be dealt with strictly as per the School’s Discipline Code already specified. This measure aims to prevent misuse of these platforms, which could harm our school community.

For online safety of your ward, it is advisable to change password at intervals of 90 days and we advise you to change the password of your ward’s School Gmail ID regularly. If unauthorized access occurs due to inadequate password management, the student will be held accountable and appropriate consequences will be enforced.

Parents are requested to closely monitor their ward’s online activities and ensure they are not administering any such groups. Your cooperation is essential in maintaining a safe and respectful environment both online and offline.
