Stream Allocation Criteria for Class XI – Academic Session 2026–27

Dear Parent

Greetings of the Day!

Your ward in Class X will appear for his/her first CBSE Board Examination at the end of this academic session. We request you to refer to the latest CBSE Notification dated 25.06.2025 (Circular No. CBSE/CE/2 - Board Examination-X / 2025) regarding the two-board exam system. Class X is a significant milestone in your child's academic journey. It is the year when your ward's hard work, dedication, and consistency will lay the foundation for a better future, as it marks the stage where they begin to chart their academic path. The stream and subject combination selected for Classes XI and XII will directly influence their higher education and career options.

The allocation of subject streams for Class XI (Academic Session 2026–27) will be based on the academic performance throughout Class X, including **Periodic Tests**, the **Mid-Term Examination**, and the **Pre-Board Examination**. All these assessments carry substantial weight in the stream allocation for Class XI (Academic Session 2026–27).

Stream Allotment Process:

Step 1. In December 2025 / January 2026, the preferred subject combination will be sought from parents.

Step 2. The final stream allocation will be determined by school authorities based on the compiled academic performance as outlined below:

- a. Marks from all Periodic Tests, the Mid-Term Examination, and the Pre-Board Examination will be compiled and totalled.
- b. A consolidated merit list will be prepared in descending order of marks.
- c. Stream allocation will be done based on this merit list:
 - The student's total marks
 - The preference indicated by the parents/student
 - The availability of seats in each stream
- d. Cut-off Marks for Streams:
 - For Science subjects, the student must secure an overall 85%, with a minimum of 90 marks each in Mathematics and Science.
 - For other combinations that include Mathematics, a minimum of 85 marks in Mathematics is required.
 - For combinations that include Applied mathematics a minimum of 75 % in Mathematics is required.
- e. Allocation will be done using a computerized system to ensure fairness, transparency, and merit-based decisions.

Please ensure that your ward works diligently to achieve good results in the upcoming Periodic Tests and the Mid-Term Examination. Given the many distractions accessible today, we once again urge you to help ensure that your child avoids these disruptions and studies with focused concentration.
