Parental Circular Preventing the Spread of Vector Borne Diseases

Dear Parent,

Greetings of the day!

Vector-borne diseases remain a silent threat, transmitted through tiny carriers yet capable of causing widespread illness. Diseases such as dengue, malaria and chikungunya, are primarily spread through the bites of infected mosquitoes. These illnesses tend to surge during the monsoon and in times of changing weather, when stagnant water becomes a breeding ground for mosquitoes. **In view of the current weather conditions we would like to recommend the adoption of essential preventive measures to safeguard the health and well-being of our students.**

We request all parents and students to take proactive measures to prevent mosquito bites and follow these precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of our students:

- Students are advised to wear full-sleeved shirts along with summer uniform trouser to minimize skin exposure to mosquito bites.
- Apply mosquito repellent creams or patches, especially during early morning and late evening hours.
- Ensure that water does not accumulate in plant pots, coolers, buckets, or any open containers at home.
- Keep the surroundings clean and dry to prevent mosquito breeding.

The school is also taking all necessary precautions within the campus to maintain hygiene and prevent mosquito breeding. We seek your continued cooperation in safeguarding the health of our children and the larger school community.
